

Our Lodge Built on stilts to minimize environmental impact, the 14 villas are spread throughout the jungle, each positioned for utmost privacy yet just a short walk from the main lodge. There are 13 standard villas and 1 Master Villa. All villas feature a private plunge pool and a spacious living area, while the Master Villa includes a larger plunge pool and living room, ideal for two couples or families. Combining the seclusion of your private Villa with opportunities to socialize at the bar and restaurant in the main lodge, Awasi Iguazú offers the perfect setting to experience the very best of Argentina's Misiones Province. 


Our Cuisine

Our Excursions

From the moment you arrive, you will be allocated your own private excursion guide and a 4WD vehicle, allowing you to explore the region at your own pace. This may mean lingering to contemplate a view, waiting patiently to capture that perfect photograph, or letting yourself be guided through the wonders of the Atlantic Rainforest.

You may choose between full-day excursions with picnic lunch included (from 6 to 10 hrs.); or two half-day excursions (from 2 to 5 hrs.), returning for lunch at Awasi's restaurant and heading out again in the afternoon for another adventure. After excursions, our guests can return to their Villa to relax by their private plunge pool.

Outings include visiting 18th century Jesuit ruins; hidden waterfalls (as well as the famous ones); kayaking through the jungle; birdwatching; viewing endemic flora and fauna; and sharing time with local Guarani tribes where guests can learn about ancient artisan crafts and the tribes' relationship with the rainforest. We hope our guests will leave with an idea of the immense beauty of the Atlantic Rainforest and the importance of conservationism in the area.

Our guides are professionally trained in archaeology, history, flora, fauna and first aid, so you can enjoy trip of a lifetime in a safe, in-depth and pleasant way. We have guides who speak English, Spanish, German, French and Portuguese, available on request. All our vehicles are equipped with GPS and communication systems.

Weather

The climate changes very little throughout the year, making Iguazú a year-round destination. Expect warmer breezes from October to April, and cooler temperatures from May to September, especially at night.

Most days are sunny and dry, however rainfall is common year-round, so best pack plenty of layers – please note that showers are frequent and heavy, but of short duration.

Average Temperatures

January to March - Rainy Season:

The most popular time to visit the Iguazu Falls as rainfall increases the water flow. Temperatures between 19°C and 32°C.

April and May:

Temperatures between 13°C and 27°C.

June to August:

Temperatures between 11°C and 24°C

September to December:

Temperatures between 13°C and 31°C

What to pack

We recommend bringing light, breathable, quick-dry synthetic clothing, including water repellent outer layers.

Other items include:

sunglasses, sunscreen, swimsuit, mosquito repellent, comfortable shoes for hiking, a backpack, water bottle (provided by Awasi upon arrival).

Any medication you may require.
