


TWO NIGHT ITINERARY

From Brazil: There are serveral flights a day from São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro and Porto Alegre with Foz do Iguaçu International Airport (IGU).

From Santiago: JetSMART airlines has one flight Santiago to Foz do Iguaçu International Airport (IGU) available twice a week.

Upon arrival, your private guide will be waiting at the airport to welcome you and transfer you to Awasi Iguazú in a private 4x4 vehicle.

Suggested Itineraries



Day 2

FULL-DAY

• Argentine Falls & Brazilian Falls

Depart early from the lodge to explore the Argentine side of Iguazú National Park, walking along elevated trails through the subtropical rainforest and taking in the spectacular waterfalls along the Upper and Lower Circuits.

Return to Awasi for lunch at the lodge before continuing to the Brazilian side of the park. Here, enjoy panoramic viewpoints that showcase the full scale of the falls and the surrounding jungle, perfect for photography and taking in the grandeur of this natural wonder.

Day 3

Devil's Throat

• Departure from Foz do Iguaçu International Airport (IGU) or Puerto Iguazú International Airport (IGR)

Start your day early to experience one of the most iconic highlights of Iguazú National Park: the Devil's Throat. Stroll along the one-kilometre boardwalk over the upper Iguazú River, surrounded by lush jungle and vibrant wildlife. Marvel at the 80-meter drop of the horshoe-shaped cascade.

Discover part of the region's best-preserved rainforest. We will drive through Iguazú National Park along National Route 101, heading east, until we reach Awasi's Yacuí Private Reserve. Along the way, you may spot unique species such as Palo Rosa trees, Palmito palms, and primitive ferns. Once there, you can enjoy kayaking and rainforest walks, and experience a traditional asado.

Day 3
